Adverse Childhood Experiences

Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) and trauma-informed care (TIC) education was delivered to six groups of nursing students from Rasmussen and Central Lake Colleges (CLC), and to new employee orientation groups, promoting a more sensitive approach to patient care across the organization and in the broader nursing community.
